Steak 44 entrees will include Petite Filet Mignon, Delmonico, NY Strip, Bone-in Filet Mignon, and Bone-in NY Strip. Guests will also be treated to other great dishes on a special section of the menu like a Bone-in Veal Chop, Chicken and Sausage, and Braised Short Rib.

At the helm will be veteran Executive Chef Marc Lupino of Dominick's Steakhouse and Steak 44 Head Chef Geoff Baumberger.
